The World Bank's 'Doing Business 2018 — Reforming to Create Jobs' report ranks 190 countries on the basis of a combined score on 10 parameters.

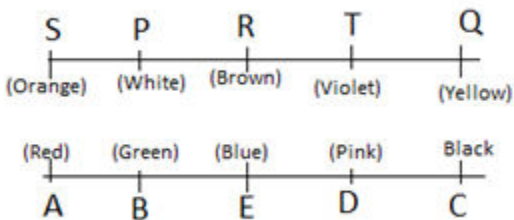
