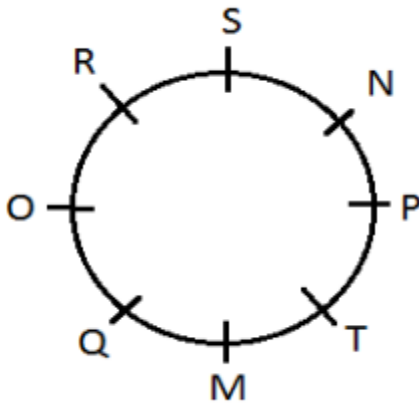

II. Some Girls can be Officers.

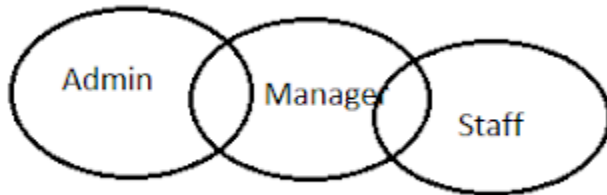
