Sol. apocalypse- an event involving destruction or damage on a catastrophic scale.

Sol. embellishment-a decorative detail or feature added to something to make it more attractive

Sol. subterfuge-deceit used in order to achieve one's goal.

Sol. augmented- having been made greater in size or value.
