Lord Irwin was the Governor-General of India during the Civil Disobedience Movement.

Civil Disobedience Movement started from Dandi March.

Ramsay Mac Donald prescribed the separate electorates for India on the basis of the Communal Award in August 1932.

Key points with regard to the **Poona Pact, 1932** are:

Acceptance of joint electorate system

Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru drafted the resolution on Fundamental Rights for the Karachi Session of Congress in 1931.

Annie Besant was the first woman President of Indian National Congress.
